ORDINANCE NUMBER 782

REGULATION OF MOTOR-DRIVEN VEHICLES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY AND PRIVATE PROPERTY

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE DATED DECEMBER 3, 1973 REGULATING THE USE OF MOTOR-DRIVEN VEHICLES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY AND PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF ROCK, ROCK COUNTY, WISCONSIN.

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF ROCK, ROCK COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

ORDINANCE NUMBER 782 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ROCK, ROCK COUNTY, WISCONSIN, IS HEREBY CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

1. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance, no person shall operate a motorcycle, motorbike, mini-bike or any other motor-driven all-terrain craft or vehicle upon the private property of another without the written consent of the owner or lessee.

2. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance no person shall operate a motorcycle, motorbike, mini-bike or any other motor-driven all-terrain craft or vehicle upon public lands within the Town of Rock, except those areas and time periods approved by the Town Board of the Town of Rock and designated on an official map to be retained by the Town Clerk of the Town of Rock.

3. All motorcycles, motorbikes, mini-bikes or any other motor-driven all-terrain crafts or vehicles are to be equipped with stock mufflers.

4. This ordinance shall not eliminate the creation of a public or private park for the operation of motorcycles, motorbikes, mini-bikes or any other motor-driven all-terrain craft or vehicle in the areas designated by the Town Board of the Town of Rock, Rock County, Wisconsin, and any person, persons, or entity desiring to establish such a private or public park shall make application for such to the Town Clerk of the Town of Rock, subject to the approval of the Town Board of the Town of Rock, Rock County, Wisconsin.

5. The operation of snowmobiles shall be exempt from the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of this ordinance and shall be regulated by Chapter 350 of the Wisconsin Statutes (1975) and any and all amendments thereto.

6. Any person who violates this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) together with the costs of prosecution for each offense, and in default of the payment of such penalty, shall be imprisoned not less than five (5) days nor more than thirty (30) days in the County Jail.

This amendment shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and posting as provided by law.
