ORDINANCE NO. 982


AN ORDINANCE BANNING THE USE OF PAINTBALL GUNS, AIRGUNS, BB GUNS, AND ANY VARIETY THEREOF IN ANY DISTRICT ZONED RESIDENTIAL, MOBILE HOME PARKS, OR INSTITUTIONAL IN THE TOWN OF ROCK, ROCK COUNTY, WISCONSIN.

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF ROCK, ROCK COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

ORDINANCE NUMBER 982 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ROCK, COUNTY OF ROCK, STATE OF WISCONSIN, IS HEREBY CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall fire or discharge, attempt to fire or discharge, or cause to be fired or discharged, any paintball gun, airgun, BB gun, pellet gun, or any similar type or variety of gun used in sporting or for fun within the following zoning districts in the Town of Rock: Residential District One (R-1), Residential District Two (R-2), Mobile Home Parks District (MHP), or Institutional District (IN), or within any zoning district which may be created to replace any of the above-listed districts in the future.
2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or any subdivision thereunder, shall be declared to be unlawful or unconstitutional at any time, it shall be deemed separable from the balance of the Ordinance and shall not affect the lawfulness or constitutionality of the remaining sections or paragraphs.
3. Any person convicted of a violation of this Ordinance is subject to a fine and shall pay to the Town of Rock, Rock County, Wisconsin, a forfeiture of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense, together with the costs of prosecution of such offense. Imprisonment in the Rock County Jail may be ordered only for failure to pay the forfeiture that may be imposed. If imprisonment is ordered for failure to pay the forfeiture, the violator shall be imprisoned in the county jail until such fine and costs are paid, but such imprisonment shall not exceed ninety (90) days.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
