

NOTICE - Public Meeting Bridge Replacement Project

IMPROVEMENTS TO BE DISCUSSED - MARCH 7, 2011

Planned reconstruction of the Hayner Road bridge over Markham Creek will be discussed at an open-house meeting scheduled for Monday, March 7, 2011 by the consulting firm Donohue & Associates, Inc. The bridge replacement project is located in the Town of Rock, west of STH 11 between O'Leary Road and Tripp Road. Construction of the project is anticipated to occur in 2012.

The open-house meeting will be held at the Rock Town Hall located at 5102 South County Road D, Afton, WI 53501 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., prior to the Town Board meeting. The meeting is being held as an open house so the public can attend at their convenience. A brief presentation is planned at 6:30 p.m. The project engineer from Donohue & Associates and local elected officials will be available to answer questions and listen to comments.

Proposed improvements include removal and replacement of the Hayner Road bridge over Markham Creek and construction of new asphalt roadway approaches. Hayner Road at the bridge site will be closed to traffic during construction and temporary easement is anticipated. The project plans will be presented and discussed in more detail at the meeting.
