What do I do with . . . ?

Latex paint – Make solid. Air-dry or add kitty litter or shredded paper. Remove lids, put with trash. For large amounts, line box with plastic, pour 1 inch deep, harden.

Latex paint recycling - earthpaintrecs.com lists area drop-offs. Ace Hardware in Janesville, Beloit, Monroe. Small fee per gallon.

Hardened non-lead, non-metallic paints, varnishes - Remove lids, place with trash.

Recycle Year Round! Many local businesses accept the following items in **LIMITED QUANTITIES** for free or a small fee. **CALL AHEAD.**

- **Earth911.com** Extensive list of recyclable items, search by ZIP code for local options.
- **Recycler list (small volume)** at Rock County Clean Sweep website or by request (754-6617 ext. 3)
- **Fluorescent bulbs:** hardware/home improvement stores. Batteries Plus. Rates and accepted bulb types vary by store; CFLs usually free. Call ahead.
- **Rechargeable and any Lithium batteries** (NiCd, NiMH, Li Ion, Li Poly) - Call2recycle.org lists several local drop-boxes. Batteries Plus. Usually free.
- **Vehicle batteries** Call auto service, supply, or salvage. Also check Earth911.com and recyclers in phone book. Often free.
- **Used motor oil:** waste hauler, auto service/supply stores. Usually 1-gallon limit, some places take up to 5 gallons. Call ahead.
- **Oil filters:** Check Earth911, some auto service/supply stores. Call ahead.
- **Antifreeze:** Some auto service/supply – call ahead. Clean Sweep.
- **Electronics, computers, printers, keyboards,** speakers, mice, DVD players, VCRs, DVRs, fax machines, cell phones, appliances, more. URT, Goodwill, electronics stores, more at Earth911.
- **Fire extinguishers:** call local fire safety suppliers.

NOTE - Alkaline batteries - Mercury-free since 1996 and not banned from WI landfills. "Trash can" symbol is for European landfill ban. Earth911.com lists mail-in programs.

What should I know?

- NO LATEX PAINT! (see next page)
- No alkaline batteries (see next page)
- Fees and/or limits may apply.
- All must RSVP (see next page)

Accepted Materials:

- Herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, and rodenticides
- **DDT; silvex; heptachlor; dieldrin; lindane; toxaphene; and 2,4,5-T**
- Acids (sulfuric, muriatic, hydrochloric) and strong bases
- Solvents (ketone, acetone, turpentine, mineral spirits)
- All lead paint (banned in 1978)
- All metallic paint
- Liquid paints, varnishes, lacquers, stains *that require solvents for thinning or clean-up*
- Photographic chemicals
- Lye
- Pool and spa chemicals, bleaches
- Wood and paint strippers (methyl chloride, others)
- Wood treatments containing penta, creosote, or arsenic
- Deck stains and driveway sealers.
- **Dairy acids**
- **General farm chemicals**
- Contaminated waste oil
- Old fuel, oil-gas mixtures
- Hydraulic fluids
- Lighter fluids, charcoal lighter, kerosene
- **Thermometers, thermostats, switches, dimmers, manometers that contain mercury. Leave devices intact.**
- **Broken fluorescent bulbs - packed airtight.**
- **Ballasts made before July 1979 for PCBs.**

Unknown Chemicals: Accepted in quantities less than 50 pounds or 5 gallons. For larger amounts of unknown chemicals, call 754-6617 ext. 118.

Drums, mini-bulks, other containers that need forklift to unload – CALL 754-6617 ext. 118.

PAINT - Max. 6 gallons of paint per home – NO LATEX. A "bin" is about the size of a laundry basket. All bins will be returned	
1 bin or equivalent	FREE
2nd, 3rd and 4th bins up to 4 total	\$5 each
More than 4 bins, all barrels and large containers (non-farm)	Conditions & rates apply
Special program for Farmsteads (active or inactive)	FREE!
First 200 lbs or approx. 110 gallons	
Farmsteads with over 200 lbs or approx. 110 gallons	Rates apply
Fluorescent bulb drop-off ... FREE Limit 5/vehicle. No incandescent, LED, HID. Many local hardware/home improvement/lighting stores recycle fluorescent bulbs ALL YEAR. CFLs/spirals often free. Call stores for details.	

Clean Sweep cannot accept:

High pressure cylinders, Freon gases, infectious and biological wastes, sharps, explosives (detonators, blasting caps, ammunition), radioactive chemicals and devices

Business Program

Businesses must use business program.

Any WI business, school or agency that generates less than 2,200 pounds of hazardous wastes (approx. four 55-gallon drums) per year may be eligible to use Clean Sweep for

cost of disposal only - no vendor mobilization costs.

To use sites in Rock County:

To use sites in Dane County:

- Open year-round. **Appointments required.**
- Dane County Business Clean Sweep www.danecountycleansweep.com
- Ag chemical discount - Rock County farms and businesses are *not* eligible for Dane Co. discount.

Can't get to Clean Sweep?

1. Protect your eyes, lungs, and skin when handling chemicals or fragile packages.
2. **DO NOT mix chemicals!**
3. Place fragile packages in separate leak-proof containers and label "Hazardous!" Clear bags are helpful!
4. Store items away from children and pets.
5. Attach this brochure to storage area as a reminder to save items for Clean Sweep!

NEED CLEAN SWEEP NOW? Dane Co. Clean

Sweep accepts hazardous chemical waste from homes and farms outside Dane Co. \$75 per drop-off. Businesses must use Business Program. Open Tuesday – Saturday all year. For hours, holiday closures, details at Dane County Clean Sweep <http://danecountycleansweep.com/>.

NOTE – It is illegal to leave items at site when closed. \$2000 forfeiture possible.
