Call To Order-Chairman Gunn called the monthly Town Board meeting to order with all Board members present.

Minutes-Supervisor Parker moved to approve the minutes as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report-Supervisor Parker moved to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried.

Planning and Zoning Committee-Supervisor Dubanowich reported the committee adopted a resolution waiving the annual review for John Goephert's paintball operation on Highway 51. No zoning permits were issued.

Zoning Officer-Dave Diestler gave his report.

Audience Communication-Peter Severson, Candidate for Clerk of Courts was present and introduced himself. There were several residents of the City of Janesville and Town of Rock present to voice their thoughts on W. Avalon Road condition and speed limit.

W. Avalon Road Maintenance-Ben Coopman, Rock County Highway Commissioner was present with a proposal from John Traynor for W. Avalon Road. The proposal is to replace the existing speed limit signs(40 mph) with 35 mph signs, centerline no passing stripes starting at Secretariat heading 600' to the west, adding a hidden driveway sign for west bound traffic at the top of hill west of Secretariat, as well as laying 100 ton of grader patch to fix some the roads defects. Reducing the speed limit may not be permitted per regulations; this will be researched. The Town had approached the City of Janesville to share the cost for grader patching and the City declined making a contribution. Attorney Wesner suggested requesting Rock County Sheriff Department to enforce the speed limit on W. Avalon Road. Deputy Molter was present and made a note of this. Supervisor Dubanowich moved to move forward with the County proposal for W. Avalon Road. Second by Supervisor Parker. Motion carried.

Farmland Preservation Map-The Farmland Preservation Map was returned.

Memorial at Airport-The Bicentennial Committee in 1982 adopted a resolution that the Memorial would stay at the Rock County Airport(Southwest Airport).
