Call To Order-Chairman Gunn called the monthly Town Board meeting to order with all Board members present.

Minutes-Supervisor Parker moved to approve the minutes as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Treasurer Report- Supervisor Parker moved to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Zoning Report-Dave Diestler gave his report.

Planning and Zoning-Supervisor Dubanowich reported, Bernier's Towing was present to address complaints Supervisor Dubanowich had received. Mark Polzin, Budget Auto Body asked about a conditional use permit to be listed as a licensed dealership; he was directed to the Town Board; no changes are required to allow this. Mike Stelter inquired about separating the current home on his parcel and building a new home; the property is zoned Agriculture Farmland Preservation; he too was directed to the Town Board. (this would not be permitted with Farmland Preservation).

Audience Communication-None

Maintenance of cemeteries-Margie Pakes was present with an amended proposal for mowing the cemetery as follows-\$360.00 per mow for Cemetery Road cemetery and \$50.00 per mow at Sherman Road cemetery, also for Cemetery Road there is an hourly rate of \$10.00 per hour for spring/storm clean up and \$15.00 per grave dressing. Supervisor Parker moved to approve the amended amounts of \$360.00 per mow, \$10.00 per hour spring/storm clean up, \$15.00 per grave dressing for Cemetery Road and \$50.00 per mow Sherman Road Cemeteries. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Rock Summer Baseball Program-Past and Present Rock Summer Baseball Program members were present to discuss the future of the currently dormant program (Ron Combs, Mark Polzin, Darrel Eggers, Ron Bomkamp, Gregg Kauffman and Chris Kolak). The census of those speaking they don't want to see the program go away forever; there needs to be a reach out to prospective Board members. Various avenues were discussed-Facebook, Town website and newsletters, infosports.com. The possibility of allowing tournaments this summer was discussed.

Road Projects-Chairman Gunn reviewed road projects for 2017. No action was necessary; it was approved last month.

Approve Bills-Supervisor Parker moved to approve payment of the invoices as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Adjourn-Supervisor Parker moved to adjourn. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich, the meeting was adjourned.
