Audience Communication-Dan Burk, 2104 S Kessler Road asked to have the field entrance reconstructed after work that was done on Kessler for the railroad; Chairman Gunn will contact the Highway Department. Pam O'Leary inquired about the possibility of dividing 40 acres into 4 parcels. Duane Mundth, 3430 Tracey Road noted potholes on Tracey; Silha should be repairing the potholes.

Act Upon Land Division-Linda/Emily Parker-Ron Combs, Combs & Associates explained what was being proposed. Chairman Gunn moved to approve the land division for Linda/Emily Parker as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried, Supervisor Parker abstained.

Resolution for Address Signs-Supervisor Parker moved to adopt the final resolution authorizing installation of signs and levying special assessments against benefited properties in the Town of Rock. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried unanimously.

Act Upon Memorandum of Understanding between Town of Beloit and Town of Rock-Supervisor Parker moved to adopt the memorandum of understanding between Town of Beloit and Town of Rock as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried unanimously.

Set Garbage/Recycle Rate-Supervisor Parker moved to levy \$167.00 per unit on the tax bills for Garbage/Recycle service. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried unanimously.

Bills-Supervisor Parker moved to approve payment of the invoices as presented with the addition of Todd's Landscaping from last month. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Adjournment-Supervisor Parker moved to adjourn. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. The meeting was adjourned.
