Call To Order-Chairman Gunn called the monthly Town Board meeting to order. All Board members were present. Attorney Lindau was absent.

Minutes-Supervisor Parker moved to approve the minutes of the monthly meeting as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Treasurer Report- Supervisor Parker moved to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried.

Zoning Report-Dave Diestler gave his zoning report. Tom Staplemann was present, Dave Diestler has talked to Tom regarding his property in the past.

Rock County Deputy-Deputy Christian was present for any citizen concerns

Planning and Zoning-Supervisor Dubanowich reported Gerry Wellnitz, Bernier Towing was at the meeting inquiring about relocating his fence. Representatives from Rock Valley Community Program were present to discuss possibly amending their conditional use permit, a public hearing is scheduled April 29 to consider doing so. Rick Thompson has been reviewing the zoning ordinance regulating the height limitation of accessory buildings in residential district 1 and agricultural district 3.

Audience Communication-None

Town Hall Landscaping-Val Heider and Tracy Heldt have been maintaining the landscaping around the town hall for several years and intend to continue. Supervisor Parker moved to allow \$750.00 to be spent on additional landscaping. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Cemetery Mowing-Margie Pakes presented a proposal for mowing the cemetery with an additional \$40 surcharge if the price of gas reaches \$3.00 per gallon. The Board asked that she continue to mow the Sherman Road Cemetery a couple of times a season. Mark Gunn will contact Rock County Public Works to possibly spray for poison ivy there. Supervisor Parker moved to approve the proposal for the cemetery mowing with the \$40.00 surcharge if the price of gas reached \$3.00 per gallon. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Custodial Replacement-Gerry Clifton has decided to step down as the custodian for the Town of Rock. Brenda Clifton expressed interest in continuing on as custodian. Supervisor Parker moved to hire Brenda Clifton as custodian for the Town of Rock with the pay being \$135 per month, \$30.00 per rental of the Town Hall, \$75.00 per snow plowing, and \$40.00 for fuel for mowing annually. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Storage/Yard Shed-The possibility of purchasing a shed for water hoses, salt, sandbag filler, other outdoor equipment housed in the Town Hall and some property stored there by others that use the Town Hall for meetings. Brenda Clifton and Supervisor Dubanowich will research possibilities and pricing.

Operator License-Supervisor Parker moved to approve operator licenses for Kenneth Cass, Kristy Austin, and Tiffany Daniels. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Bills-Supervisor Parker moved to approve payment of the invoices as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Adjournment-Supervisor Parker moved to adjourn. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 pm.
