Call To Order-Chairman Gunn called the public hearing to order to consider amending the zoning ordinance changing the maximum height of detached garages and accessory buildings in Residential District 1 (R-1) and Agricultural District 3 (A-3) to 20'. Rick Thompson spoke in support of the amendment. Tony Dubanowich and Chris Dodge spoke in support of the amendment as well. No one spoke in opposition. The public hearing was closed.

Call To Order-Chairman Gunn called the monthly Town Board meeting to order. All Board members were present.

Minutes-Supervisor Parker moved to approve the minutes of the monthly meeting as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Treasurer Report- Supervisor Parker moved to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried.

Zoning Report-Dave Diestler gave his zoning report.

Planning and Zoning-Supervisor Dubanowich reported the Planning and Zoning Committee approved an amended conditional use permit for Caravilla, Inc. and gave a favorable recommendation for the amendment to the zoning ordinance as noticed.

Audience Communication-Margo Murray noted she did not receive her notice for the e-waste until after the collection was done; this will be addressed for the next collection. Leo Muller asked about noxious weeds, Weed Commissioner Judy Thostenson will address this.

Amend Zoning Ordinance- Supervisor Parker moved to adopt Ordinance No. 2019-04 amending Residential District 1 (R-1) and Agricultural District 3 (A-3) increasing the maximum height for detached garages and accessory buildings to 20'. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

5513 S Driftwood Drive-Chris Dodge reported a shed has been built at 5513 S Driftwood Drive without a permit, the setbacks are in violation as well. Supervisor Dubanowich recommended having Attorney Lindau send a letter addressing the non-compliance.

Weed Commissioner-Supervisor Parker moved to appoint Judy Thostenson as Weed Commissioner. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Utility Shed for Town Hall-Brenda Clifton had some information regarding utility sheds. She will have more detail next month.

Town of Rock Park-Rock County Public Works has spoken with Chairman Gunn to possibly use the Town of Rock Park.

Road Projects-Chairman Gunn presented a proposed schedule of road projects for 2019 after conferring with Rock County Public Works after the Town Board inspected the roads with them. Supervisor Parker moved to approve the road projects as proposed. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Operator License-Supervisor Parker moved to approve operator licenses for Michael Kelly, Patricia Mazza, Lexie Coplien, Misty Allen, Heidi Moore, Supanary Shelton, Jeffrey Wiskia, Shelby Dewey, Ann McGrath, Matina Tzivleris and Zachary Lucas. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Bills-Supervisor Parker moved to approve payment of the invoices as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Adjournment-Supervisor Parker moved to adjourn. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. The meeting was adjourned at 9:15 pm.
