Call To Order-Chairman Gunn called the monthly Town Board meeting to order. All Board members were present.

Minutes-Supervisor Parker noted a correction of the minutes that Bob Fahey was to be hired to complete the commercial inspections for Nutrien Ag. Supervisor Parker moved to approve the minutes of the monthly meeting as amended. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Treasurer Report- Supervisor Parker moved to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Zoning Report-No report.

Planning and Zoning-Supervisor Dubanowich reported Jack Betenz came to Planning and Zoning regarding a neighbor that had done some construction. The Betenz's were at the Town Board meeting as well. Chris Dodge and Supervisor Dubanowich had spoken with the party in question because of a lack of the permit.

Audience Communication-Margo Murray asked Officer Albeck how many complaints were received on County Parks. It varies for each park.

Future of the Town Park-Chairman Gunn updated events leading to the issue of how to proceed with the Town Park. John Traynor, Rock County Parks Manager was present to review the County's proposal if they purchased the Town Park. Several residents were present expressing they would like to have it remain a Town Park. There has been an offer to purchase 40 acres for \$130,000 from a neighbor of the Park. A Committee was formed and will do research, report back to the Town Board in December possibilities for the Town to maintain it as a park.

Permit Fees-Supervisor Dubanowich and Inspector Tim Kienbaum will meet to review the permit fee schedule for the Town.

Comprehensive Plan Amendment-A Joint meeting with the Town Board and Planning and Zoning Committee will be October 28 at 6:30 pm.

The E-Waste dates for 2020 were set for April 18 and September 19.

The Garbage/Recycle fee was set at \$172.00 per unit to be levied on the tax bill.

Clean Sweep-Supervisor Parker moved to donate \$500.00 to Rock County Clean Sweep. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Bills-Supervisor Parker moved to approve payment of the invoices as presented. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Adjournment-Supervisor Parker moved to adjourn. Second by Supervisor Dubanowich. The meeting was adjourned.
