Chairman Gunn called the monthly Town Board meeting to order with all Board members present.

Supervisor Parker moved to approve the minutes as presented. Second by Supervisor Connell. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Supervisor Connell moved to approve the financial report as presented. Second by Supervisor Parker. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Planning and Zoning Report-Representatives from Rock Valley Corrections Program reviewed their proposal to house vets at the facility; they invited members to come for a tour of the facility.

Audience Communications-Doug Rebout, 6401 Mineral Point Rd, invited Board members to attend Focus on Agriculture open house June 30, 2010-10:00 am at his family farm located at 5606 W Mineral Point Rd, Janesville, WI. Alan Hollenberger, 6507 S County Road D questioned when a brush pile was going to be moved on his neighbors parcel. Follow up will be done on this. Scot Arnold questioned No Parking signs on County D in Afton facing the road instead of traffic; this will be looked into. Chuck Niles notified the Board his solar system was up and running.

Last month fees for cemetery lots was determined. Chairman Gunn had estimates for fencing from Simmons and Lemke Fencing Companies. Dennis Simmons was present to address any questions. Chairman Gunn proposed paying for the fence half from Town funds and half from Cemetery funds. Supervisor Connell moved to fence the entire cemetery with Simmons Fencing as the contractor, using 9 gauge light commercial fence, Ron Combs will be asked to mark the corners up to the lot line, cemetery funds are to be used for the entire project. Second by Supervisor Parker. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Attorney Wesner reviewed the proposal from Waste Management for rates. Supervisor Connell moved to accept the proposal with the higher rate, with the \$3 fuel surcharge contingent upon negotiating a new contract with terms and conditions satisfactory to both parties. Second by Supervisor Parker. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Chairman Gunn, Attorney Wesner, Attorney Moore met with Rock County Corporation Counsel regarding the raze order for the Zabel home on S. River Road. A raze order will be issued for this property.

Supervisor Connell moved to approve the liquor license as noticed with the exception of removing the outdoor smoking patio and deck from Bobbleheads' license. Second by Supervisor Parker. Motion carried with a voice vote. Supervisor Connell moved to approve liquor license for Chubby Bubba's with stipulation that there was no change from last year. Second by Supervisor Parker. Motion carried with a voice vote.
